San Diego, December 4, 2007 – Kevin Gerard, a San Diego author, will celebrate the release of the second book in his popular series, Conor and the Crossworlds, at a private reception, Sunday, December 9, at six o'clock. The three hour gathering will be held at Trisler's Wine Bar in Mission Valley.

Peril in the Corridors, the second book in the Conor and the Crossworlds series, sends Conor on a mind-blowing series of battles against the Circle of Evil's finest team of destroyers. In order to give Maya the time he needs to repair the corridors, Conor must defeat a human-dragon mutant, a formless entity, and a shape-shifting master of darkness. Infused with the power of the Crossworlds Champions, Conor fights against insurmountable odds at each juncture, only to find his most powerful foe waiting for him at the end of his amazing adventure

The Conor and the Crossworlds story opens with Breaking the Barrier, a ten year old boy's journey aboard Purugama, a champion and protector of the Crossworlds. It is garnering attention across the country, and Mr. Gerard will be traveling as far as the Eastern Seaboard next spring to meet requests for author talks at schools and libraries.

The remaining three novels in the series, already written by Mr. Gerard, will be released each holiday season, starting with Conor and the Crossworlds, Surviving an Altered World, in December of 2008.

Kevin Gerard has written short stories for the highly popular Chicken Soup for the Soul books for years. In October, 2006, he appeared on the KUSI Morning Show with Sandra Maas to discuss one of the Chicken Soup collections.
